

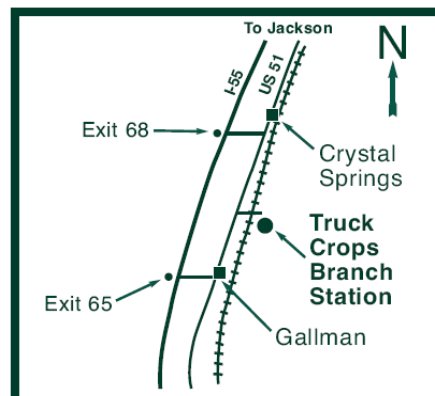
HIGH TUNNEL FIELD DAY
